THE PARABLES OF JESUS ACCORDING TO LUKE: THE PHARISEE AND TAX COLLECTOR

Luke 18:9-14

BIG IDEA: True <u>exaltation</u> in God's Kingdom comes through <u>humility</u>.

THE PHARISEE: A MODEL OF SELF-RIGHTEOUSNESS (vv. 10-12)

We must seek God's mercy not <u>self-justification</u>. (Psalm 51:1-2)

There is a danger in <u>comparing</u> ourselves to others. (2 Corinthians 10:12)

THE TAX COLLECTOR: A MODEL OF HUMILITY (v. 13)

We must recognize and acknowledge our sin. (Isaiah 59:1-2)

Humility should be our <u>posture</u>. (Micah 6:8)

TWO DIFFERENT PRAYERS

The Pharisee's Prayer: A Prayer of Pride. (Proverbs 16:18)

The Tax Collector's Prayer: A Prayer of Repentance. (2 Chronicles 7:14)

APPLICATIONS FOR OUR LIVES

We must regularly examine our own hearts and motivations. (Jeremiah 17:9-10)

We should approach our relationships with <u>humility</u>. (*Philippians 2:2-4*)

We should foster an environment where <u>vulnerability</u> is encouraged. (Hebrews 10:24-25)
