BIG IDEA: True repentance will produce fruit.

## THE CONTEXT (vv. 12:49-13:5)

The cause of <u>division</u> (12:49-53)

The call to consider the signs of the <u>times</u> (12:54-56)

The call to settle one's accounts and repent (12:57-13:5)

## **THE PARABLE (vv. 13:6-9)**

Many see the fig tree as a reference to <u>Israel</u>.

Many believe this is a reference to The <u>Destruction</u> of <u>Jerusalem</u> in 70 A.D.

The main point is to repent now.

## **KEY LESSONS**

Where God has extended <u>privileges</u>, He expects <u>returns</u>. (John 15:8, Matthew 21:43)

The Lord is longsuffering, but it doesn't last forever. (2 Peter 3:9-10)

Those who are <u>unfruitful</u> will be <u>cut off</u>. (John 15:2-6)
