THE PARABLES OF JESUS ACCORDING TO LUKE: TAKING THE LOWEST PLACE

Luke 14:7-11

BIG IDEA: Humility is about descending into greatness.

THE SETTING

Jesus is dining at the house of a prominent <u>Pharisee</u> on the Sabbath.

Jesus was being watched carefully.

A man with dropsy is healed.

The guests could not <u>reply</u> to what had just happened.

THE PARABLE

Human tendency is to seek self-promotion and status.

Exaltation of self can often lead to shame.

True honor in God's Kingdom is not about self-promotion, but rather self-abasement.

LESSONS LEARNED

Humility as a <u>virtue</u>. (Colossians 3:12, Proverbs 22:4, Psalm 149:4)
<u>Reversal</u> of worldly values. (Matthew 20:16, 23:11-12)
Application to <u>social</u> interactions. (Colossians 4:5-6)
Embracing God's <u>grace</u>. (Ephesians 2:4-5)
