LIVING OUT SOUND DOCTRINE: LIVING GODLY LIVES

Titus 2:1-10

March 23, 2025

BIG IDEA: Godly living flows from sound doctrine making the gospel attractive to others.

SOUND DOCTRINE LEADS TO GODLY LIVING (v. 1)

Sound doctrine is not just about knowledge-it transforms our character and conduct.

We must ensure that our faith is rooted in biblical truth.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR VARIOUS GROUPS IN THE CHURCH (vv. 2-10a)

Older Men (v. 2) – Be dignified, self-controlled, sound in faith, love, and steadfastness.

<u>Older Women</u> (v. 3) – Live reverently, avoid slander, and teach younger women.

Younger Women (vv. 4-5) – Be loving, pure, self-controlled, and diligent at home.

Younger Men (v. 6) – Pursue self-control and integrity.

Workers (vv. 9-10) – Work with honesty, submission, and excellence to honor God.

THE PURPOSE OF GOOD WORKS (v. 10b)

Our conduct should reflect the beauty and the power of the gospel.

Our actions either draw people toward Christ or push them away.
