## AN UNDIVIDED HEART FOR GOD: THE ARROGANCE OF WEALTH

James 4:13-5:6

July 21, 2024

**BIG IDEA:** A <u>God-centered</u> life uses our time and wealth wisely.

## WEALTH AND PRESUMPTION (vv. 4:13-17)

Life is <u>uncertain</u>. (*Proverbs 27:1*) <u>Plan</u> according to God's will. (*Proverbs 16:9*) We are <u>obligated</u> to do what we now know. (*Luke 12:47-48*)

## WEALTH AND EXPLOITATION (vv. 5:1-6)

Money can lead to the misery of judgment. (Proverbs 11:28) Hoarding wealth is spiritually short-sighted. (Luke 18:22-24) Defrauding others is injustice. (Jeremiah 22:13) Self-indulgence will lead to destruction. (1 Timothy 6:9-10) Greed can drive people to oppress others. (Proverbs 1:19)
