ADVENT: THE PRICE OF PEACE Colossians 1:19-20

December 8, 2024

BIG IDEA: Peace comes with a price.

THE SOURCE OF PEACE: CHRIST'S FULLNESS (v. 19)

The <u>fullness</u> of God dwells in Christ.

The peace Jesus brings carries the <u>authority</u> and <u>completeness</u> of God Himself.

Immanuel, God with us, brings His peace to a broken world.

THE SCOPE OF PEACE: RECONCILIATION OF ALL THINGS (v. 20a)

The peace Christ brings is <u>cosmic</u> in scope.

This echoes the <u>fall</u> in Genesis and points to Christ as the <u>restorer</u> of all things.

This peace isn't merely personal-it impacts societies and the entire created order.

THE <u>COST</u> OF PEACE: THE BLOOD OF HIS CROSS (v. 20b)

The cross is the ultimate <u>demonstration</u> of God's love and justice.

Jesus <u>atoned</u> for sin and removed the <u>barrier</u> between God and humanity.

Advent reminds us that the cradle leads to the cross.
