AN UNDIVIDED HEART FOR GOD: THE WORLD OR GOD?

James 4:4-12

July 14, 2024

BIG IDEA: Our motives and desires often determine who or what we will follow.

#### THE JEALOUSY OF GOD (vv. 4-5)

Flirting with the world can lead to spiritual <u>adultery</u>. (1 John 2:15-17)

The Spirit which <u>dwells</u> in us jealously yearns for our entire <u>devotion</u>. (John 14:16-17)

## THE GRACE OF GOD (v. 6)

God's grace is greater than any of our trials or burdens. (2 Corinthians 12:9)

Grace is given to those who <u>hunger</u> and <u>thirst</u> for God. (*Psalm 107:9*)

### **SUBMITTING TO GOD (vv. 7-10)**

We must <u>surrender</u> to our King, and start receiving the benefits of His reign. (*Proverbs* 3:5-6)

Satan will oppose us when we pursue Jesus. (Ephesians 6:10-12)

Submission to God involves <u>humility</u> and <u>confession</u> of sins. (1 John 1:8-9)

#### **JUDGING GOD'S LAW (vv. 11-12)**

<u>Discerning</u> someone's character and/or teaching is not judging. (1 John 4:1)

We are <u>unqualified</u> to be the judge over others. (Romans 2:1-3)
