BIG IDEA: Being united in Christ we should communicate <u>truth</u> in <u>love</u>.

GOD HAS APPOINTED GOVERNMENT TO...

Promote good and punish evil. (Romans 13:1-7, 1 Peter 2:13-17)

TWO DITCHES

Ditch #1-Partisan ideology that is promoted over biblical theology.

Ditch #2-Quietism that is silent on important issues.

WHEN THE CHURCH IS TOO POLITICAL...

It distorts our <u>identity</u>. (*Galatians 2:20*) It divides our <u>body</u>. (*John 17:23*) It destroys our <u>witness</u>. (*Acts 1:8*) It distracts from our <u>mission</u>. (*Matthew 28:18-20*)

WHAT IS OUR ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES AS THE CHURCH?

Care about justice and righteousness. (Proverbs 8:13, Psalm 82:3-4) Don't be surprised by injustice. (Ecclesiastes 5:8) Don't trust in princes. (Psalm 118:9, 146:3) God can use wicked rulers for His purposes. (Romans 9:17, Daniel 4) Stop arguing over opinions. (Romans 14:1, 15:5-6) Pray for our rulers. (1 Timothy 2:1-4)
